Save Time & Money

- EDI billing eliminates the need to create a paper invoice and more importantly the labor expense required to match collateral documents such as Bills of Lading and Delivery Receipts to ensure proof of service.
- EDI eliminates the stationary, stuffing and postage expenses of paper invoices.



Make Communication Easier

- We support EDI/web-based payment inquiries from carriers, eliminating the need for phone calls.
- Direct FTP, Secure FTP or AS2 connections are used to eliminate VAN costs.
- We enable carriers to transfer files via the internet and use unassisted technology to improve efficiency, which requires the sender to push their files to the receiver's FTP site. PGP encryption is used by TranzAct; however inbound files do not require PGP due to the validation routines the files are subject to upon receipt.
- We offer real-time access to EDI data via our online portal, My TranzAct Carrier.



Reduce Errors & Re-work

- EDI eliminates the possibility of invoices getting lost in the mail. Combining this with TranzAct's schedule payment feature allows all freight expenses to be settled within the number of days the client has negotiated with you, which creates a more regular payment schedule.
- TranzAct provides EDI payment remittance information which eliminates the data entry of receivable information and ensures the proper allocation by correct pro-number. This process also informs you of any exception that occurred in processing so you can route this information to the exception clerk responsible for a given account and make a timely correction.
