FMC to Establish Innovation Teams to Address COVID-19 Challenges

Last week the FMC issued an <u>order</u> opening up a fact finding investigation that gives authority to Commissioner Rebecca Dye to develop solutions to delivery challenges at US ports caused by COVID-19. To support that effort, the FMC has authorized Commissioner Dye to develop one or more supply chain innovation teams "that will represent all facets of the ocean cargo system including public port authorities, marine terminal operators, beneficial cargo owners, ocean transportation intermediaries, liner shipping companies, drayage trucking companies, longshore labor representatives, rail officials, and chassis providers."

Like the innovation teams associated with Fact Finding Investigation 29, Commissioner Dye would like members of the industry (rather than trade association staff) to serve on the team(s). If you have an interest in participating, or sharing information with FMC, contact
